Our primary goal is to protect, preserve and restore our bodies of water around our beautiful island in order to continue enjoying our passion; fishing and other related activities.

We aim to impact the ocean, estuaries, rivers and lakes that serve as our main fishing grounds. Also we are involved in other areas that are related to protecting our environment, through education and field activities.

Last year, inspired by a Sport Fishing Magazine Editorial, we organized two major activities; Mega Clean Up I and II. Between those two activities, we were able to enlist an army of more than 800 volunteers. In approximately 6 hours, we collected more than 70,000 pounds of garbage that were floating in and around our beautiful estuary.

Our passion for fishing and to protect our marine environment drew the attention of the Guy Harvey Ocean Foundation. The GHOF has been an instrumental part in PPA's development and ongoing success.

In October 26, 2013, Guy Harvey witnessed what a Mega Clean Up is all about. He was our special guest at the Mega Limpieza II.

Mega Limpieza I & II:

Mega Clean up or "Mega Limpieza", are our signature activities. They are unique in that they combine action and education for our valuable volunteers. Our volunteers come from all ages and from all parts of the island. Last year our volunteers were able to clean our estuary by water and by foot. It was quite an experience seeing groups of all ages, social classes, government and sponsors all united for one purpose, our environment. Volunteers worked in kayaks, boats and by foot cleaning our mangroves and waters that are the home of the famous Tarpons!



After the Clean Ups end, our volunteers have a well deserved lunch courtesy of our sponsors. Then in the afternoon the educational aspect takes place. We have educational workshops given by local and foreign professionals in their respective areas of expertise. At the end of the day, we have our famous raffle, all from products donated by our generous sponsors.

These two Mega Clean Up, have also drawn the attention of local and international press in part by the support of Guy Harvey.

Future Plans:

We have another Mega Clean Up planned for June 2014. We are also engaging with the Shark Free/Friendly Marina initiative in Puerto Rico, among other projects.

Last but not least, we are leading an effort to educate the fishing community and the government about the importance of implementing a NET BAN in Puerto Rico. We want to ban gill nets from our waters. But we need your support!
